1. General Notice

All chairs, moderators, and presenters are kindly requested to attend and present **onsite at the designated venue**. Please read the following instructions carefully to ensure smooth operations on the day of the session.

2. For Chairs and Moderators

- Onsite check-in is **not required**.
- Please arrive at your session room and take your seat at the "Next Chair/Moderator" area at least 10 minutes before the scheduled session start.
- Session progress is under your discretion; however, we kindly request **strict adherence to the allocated presentation and discussion times** for timely proceedings.

3. For Presenters

Check-in and Seating

- Presenters must complete check-in at the "Presenter/PC Reception Desk" at least 30 minutes before their session.
- Please be seated at the "Next Presenter" area no later than 10 minutes prior to the session.

Presentation Time

- Designated Presentations (Symposia, Committee Sessions): As previously notified
- **General Presentations**: 5 minutes for presentation + 3 minutes for discussion

Presentation Operation

- Slide operation will be carried out by the presenter using the podium equipment.
- Time signals:
 - Yellow light 1 minute remaining
 - Red light End of time

- Submit data via USB flash drive
- Supported formats: Microsoft PowerPoint 2013/2016/2019/2021/365
- Slide ratio: 16:9
- Use only system fonts:

Japanese → MS Gothic, MS Mincho, MSP Gothic, MSP Mincho

English → Times New Roman, Arial, Century, Courier New, Georgia, etc.

Videos and animations are permitted.

File format: **WMV or MP4** (resolution: 720p or 1080p)

Videos must be embedded in the presentation

• Run a virus scan using the latest antivirus software prior to submission.

Mac Users

- Bring your own Mac laptop and HDMI adapter/conversion cable
- Projector input: **HDMI only**
- Disable screensavers, passwords, and power-saving settings beforehand

- Power cable is mandatory; battery operation is not recommended
- Provide a **USB backup** of your presentation
- Venue staff will collect and return your PC at the "Next Presenter" seat

- Use of PowerPoint versions **outside the supported list** may cause technical issues; the organizers shall not be responsible for any malfunctions.
- Do not use image files in **HEIC format**; convert to JPEG, PNG, TIFF, GIF, or BMP.

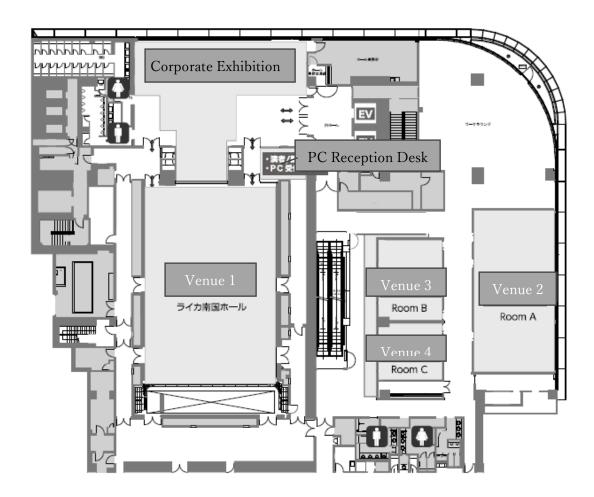

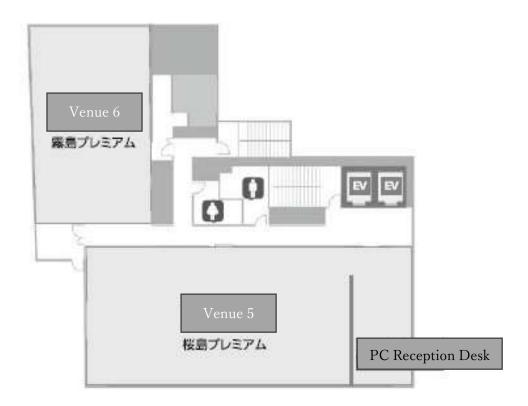
